I-HI-MI-L Building Style- ¶6 the discussion included "style is important. Walls are used to separate the area(s). A consistent setback is recommended. Heavy industrial use also needs a consistent setback w/ parking lots included in the setback. A minimum setback of 50' is recommended, 25' for the side yard. Light Industrial should have a 50' setback and Medium Industrial should have a 60' setback. For Residential areas the side yard needs to be 50'. Side setback for Industrial must allow for firetrucks.
