

Regular Meeting  
August 14, 2012

The regular meeting of the Mount Jackson Town Council was scheduled for August 14, 2012 at 7:30 p.m. in Council Chambers at 5901 Main Street. Roll call was taken with the following in attendance: Joseph Williams, Mayor, Kenneth Hackenbracht, and Rodney Shepherd. Absent: Dennis Andrick, Todd Holtzman, Donnie Pifer, and Kay P. Whetzel, Councilmembers. Also present: Doug Arthur, Town Attorney, Clark Draper, Town Manager, Neil Showalter, Finance Director, and Judy Fultz, Clerk. Visitors present: Chris Brown and Peter Shoemaker.

The meeting was cancelled due to: No sufficient number for a quorum.

Peter Shoemaker stated he was looking at the billing for utilities. He has never used more than the minimum amount. He was advised there are three businesses in the building. He is being billed for three minimum bills – one for each business. He feels he is being singled out. He has talked to Town Manager Clark Draper and Finance Director Neil Showalter.
