Water Rate Increase

The Town Council approved a rate increase for water and sewer effective August 2019 billing cycle. The 2,000-gallon minimum **was** \$39.10, excluding trash service, it will change **to** \$39.70 for 2,000 gallons excluding trash service.

The cost per thousand gallons of water will be \$7.20 and for sewer \$12.65. It is important to note the town reads in *thousands* of gallons.
